

**EXCERPT FROM THE DECISIONS OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL**  
**Protocol No. 33 of 15 December 2025**

**regarding** the approval of an update to the budget of the Medical University of Varna for 2025

The Academic Council approves the update of budget 2025 of the Medical University of Varna by paragraphs and activities under the Unified Budget Classification, as follows:

1. An increase in transfers in the amount of BGN 7,187, in accordance with Appendix 1.
2. An increase in expenditure in the amount of BGN 7,187 and internally compensatory changes by paragraphs of the Unified Budget Classification, in accordance with Appendix 1.
3. Approves a maximum amount of expenditure for representational purposes for 2025 in the amount of BGN 700,000.

**regarding** the update of basic monthly salaries (BMS)

The Academic Council decided as follows:

1. With effect from 1 December 2025, the basic monthly salaries (BMS) for a full-time position of the staff shall be increased by BGN 300.
2. The basic monthly salaries shall be determined as whole numbers in euros, in favour of the employee, so that as of 1 January 2026 the agreed basic monthly salary of each employee shall be a whole number in euros. The amount shall be rounded up to the next higher unit if, after the increase and currency conversion, there is a digit greater than zero after the decimal point.
3. For employees appointed to less than a full-time position, the basic salary shall be determined proportionally to the indexed basic salary for a full-time position, rounded to a whole number, in compliance with the principle described in item 2.
4. The basic monthly remuneration of employees whose employment contracts are subject to a probationary period shall be updated in accordance with items 1 and 2, and after the expiry of the probationary period – with the increases applied during the probationary period up to the amount set for the respective position within the structure.
5. Approves basic salaries for the academic staff positions at the Medical University of Varna, in accordance with Appendix No. 1 hereto.
6. The new amounts of the basic salaries of the staff shall be determined with effect from 1 December 2025 for all persons who are in an employment relationship with the Medical University of Varna as of the date of this decision. For employment contracts concluded after 1 December 2025, the increased basic salary amounts shall apply from the date of conclusion of the respective individual employment contract.
7. The remuneration of employees working under a primary employment contract and/or a contract for additional work for the implementation of activities under projects and programmes shall not be updated.
8. Authorises the Rector, in cases where the calculated basic salary of an employee does not correspond to the decision adopted under item 2, to determine the basic remuneration in accordance with its wording.

**II.** Authorises the Rector, in the event of amendments or supplements to the regulatory framework related to the above decisions, to determine individual remuneration in accordance with labour legislation.

**III.** Appendix 1 to the Internal Rules for Salaries at the Medical University of Varna, entitled "*Minimum Basic Salaries by Position and Staff Category*", shall be updated in accordance with Article 16, paragraph 6 of the Internal Rules for Salaries. In this regard, a new § 35 shall be created with the following wording:  
"The Internal Rules for Salaries have been amended and supplemented by a decision of the

2. Approves the template of the authorization letter for the upcoming 2026/2027 academic year (Annex 2).
3. The companies approved under item 1 shall be issued an authorization letter according to the relevant template, granting them the opportunity to promote and advertise the university, including through the use of promotional materials provided by Medical University – Varna (photos, videos, brochures, etc.), and to present the admission conditions to prospective foreign applicants.
4. Medical University – Varna does not enter into contracts with intermediary companies and does not pay any remuneration, including commissions, for applicants referred by them.
