INSTRUCTIONS

Abstract submission

- 1. Abstracts should be saved in .doc or .docx format;
- 2. Page setup Margins: Top 2.5 cm; Bottom 2.5 cm; Left 2.5 cm; Right 2.5 cm;
- 3. Paper Size A4;
- 4. Font Times New Roman; Font Style Regular; Size 12;
- 5. Paragraph Line Spacing: Single; Spacing: Before 0 pt; After 8 pt;
- 6. The title is written in capital letters, centered, Bold;
- 7. The names of the authors, first and last names, without abbreviations and their affiliations are written on a new line;
- 8. After one blank line with an indentation, Special, First line 1.27 cm, ABSTRACT is written in capital letters, Bold;
- 9. Each section is written with each word in capital letters, Bold, after which the main text is written;
- 10. After the summary, on a new line, "Keywords" are in Bold, and the keywords are in Italic;
- 11. In case of project funding, a fifth section is added in the abstract: Acknowledgement/Funding "This study is financed by.....".

Poster Requirements

- 1. Format and Display:
- Poster must be prepared on paper measuring 60x90 cm vertically;
- 2. Content Structure: Each poster must include the following clearly labeled sections:
- Title, Authors, and Affiliations;
- Introduction;
- Aim and Objectives;
- Results and Discussion;
- Conclusion.
- 3. All posters must be prepared in English.

Oral Presentation Requirements

- 1. The presentation duration should not exceed 10 minutes.
- 2. All presentations should be prepared in English, but can be presented in Bulgarian.
