Prof. Dr. Boryana Naydenova, PhD. – Head of the Department of Anesthesiology, Emergency Medicine and Intensive Care medicine" and decision under protocol No. 33/20.01.2025 of the faculty council of Faculty of Medicine for the academic position of Associate Professor in the field of higher education 7. "healthcare and sports", from vocational field 7.1. "medicine" and the scientific specialty "Anesthesiology and intensive care" for the needs of the Department of Anesthesiology, emergency medicine and intensive medicine at the Faculty of Medicine of the Medical University of Varna and Clinic "Anesthesiology and Intensive Care" at the University Hospital "St. Marina" - Varna.

There is only one candidate participating in the competition – Dr. Petya Marincheva Ivanova, PhD., who fulfills all the necessary requirements for participation in a competition for academic position "associate professor", listed in the Academic Development Regulations of the Medical University "Prof. Dr. Paraskev Stoyanov" - Varna.

Dr. Petya Ivanova, PhD was born on November 14, 1982 in Varna. She graduated Medical University "Prof. Dr. P. Stoyanov" - Varna in 2007. She obtained a specialty in "Anesthesiology and Intensive Care" in 2013. She has 17 years of medical experience. The candidate's academic development began in 2009 as an assistant professor in the specialty "Anesthesiology and Intensive Care" Department of anesthesiology, intensive care and emergency medicine at the Medical University - Varna. Since 2019 she has held the position Chief Assistant Professor. Successfully defended his dissertation on the topic "Ultrasonic navigated femoral block – a method for pain relief in patients after knee joint endoprosthesis" receives a scientific and educational degree "Doctor of Philosophy" in 2018.

Her professional development began as a doctor at Clinic of Anesthesiology and Intensive Care - University Hospital "St. Marina" - Varna in 2008, and since 2009 he has

been a specialist in "Anesthesiology and intensive care". In 2013 he acquired a specialty in "Anesthesiology and intensive care."

She has had 9 continuing specializations in Bulgaria and abroad in leading medical institutions.

She is fluent in English and German.

The candidate presents one dissertation, one monograph for the competition, as well as 16 full text publications in foreign and Bulgarian journals.

In 2023, he published a monograph on the topic "Sepsis. Biomarkers in sepsis" in a print run of 200 copies, which received high praise from respected specialists on a national scale. The habilitation thesis is written according to modern requirements, meets all scientometric criteria, mentioned in the Academic Development Regulations of the Medical University – Varna. Offers an algorithm for assessment and selection of a treatment method for the disease, which makes it a valuable tool for residents and specialists in anesthesiology and intensive care with a focus in this area. The presented list of publications demonstrates a wide thematic scope, multidisciplinary approach to the treatment of diseases. The individual
