General Bulgarian

Language

First course

The Course in General Bulgarian consists of two parts spread along the first and second year at the university. It is intended for foreign students of dental medicine.

The aim of the first part (first dental medical course, level A1 – A2) of the course is to provide basic language competences in Bulgarian as follows:

A. Communicative skills

1. Listening – Understanding sentences, short monologues and dialogues in Bulgarian with general social and cultural topics read with moderate speed, clear articulation and standard pronunciation.

2. Reading - Understanding the key information from texts in standard Bulgarian:

- ◆ Short stories; not complex descriptions and narrative stories with opportunity to identify certain socio-cultural specifics;
- ◆ Finds, understands and takes away specific information in: instructions and working guidelines, academic texts; invitations; messages; posters; study guides and textbooks;
- ◆ Uses compensatory strategies: guidance by the title and international lexis; context; relying on illustrations; takes into account international terms and familiar patterns of word formation; uses reference books.

3. Writing – writing independently own text approximately 50 words (short biographic data, answering questions; description; essay on specific topic, key words or illustrative material; greeting; invitation; personal letter).

Uses language tools, spelling and punctuation do not impede understanding. Applies basic spelling and punctuation principles in compliance with the norms of the Bulgarian literary language.

4. Speaking

- ◆ Having a simple conversation on familiar topics by asking and answering specific and explicit questions, follows and gives simple instructions;

3. Writing – writing independently own text approximately 50 words (short biographic data, answering questions; description; essay on specific topic, key words or illustrative material; greeting; invitation; personal letter).

Uses language tools, spelling and punctuation do not impede understanding. Applies basic spelling and punctuation principles in compliance with the norms of the Bulgarian literary language.

4. Speaking

- ◆ Having a simple conversation on familiar topics by asking and answering specific and explicit questions, follows and gives simple instructions;

- ◆ Presenting in short past events, speaks for present and future; expresses future intentions;
- ◆ Leading simple discussions on familiar topics in previously defined frameworks;
- ◆ Presenting short simple text – e.g. for a person, object, event (based on pre-arranged plan);
- ◆ Having a short conversation on unfamiliar topic.

In all four skills understanding and performing **communicative tasks** such as: objective message; approval and denial; asking simple questions; giving answers; expressing request, order, wish, invitation, denial, disagreement; expressing emotions and excitement; expressing basic definitions, descriptions, comparisons, quantitative and qualitative relations; distinguishing between primary and secondary information in the text when reading and listening; presenting an opinion on a given topic in oral and written;

In view of the above objectives, the course covers the following grammar topics: Grammar:

1. Nouns. Gender, singular and plural, definite and indefinite articles. Use.
2. Adjectives. Gender, singular and plural, agreement, degrees of comparison, use in connected speech.
3. Numerals. Ordinal. Articulation and agreement of the ordinals.
4. Pronouns. Types. Word order
5. Verbs. Conjugation. Verb tenses.
Participles
6. Adverbs.
7. Prepositions
8. Simple sentences. Subject, verb, objects. Word order.
9. Complex sentences.
10. Direct speech.

FORM/ FORMAT OF INSTRUCTION:

- Lectures.
- Seminars.
- Two midterm tests.

Achievements are evaluated according to European standards of language competence on individual communication skills. The exam is taken on success above 63% for the four language skills – level A2. Each student receives European certification for Bulgarian language proficiency level A2.

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

1. **Listening** - the student must demonstrate the ability to understand the general sense of a conversation between two native speakers on a topic related to the student's experience and of simple public utterances.
2. **Oral communication** - the student must demonstrate the ability to communicate in everyday situations requiring a simple and direct exchange of information.
3. **Reading** - the student must demonstrate the ability to understand the general sense of short, simple items on familiar topics.
4. **Writing** - the student must demonstrate the ability to write brief items relevant to everyday situations and conveying basic information.

FINAL EXAM – LEVEL A2

The final exam consists of two parts for the assessment of:

- I. **PASSIVE SKILLS:** Reading and Listening (Computer based test with a total of 40 items)
- II. **ACTIVE SKILLS:** Speaking and Writing.

Reading and listening contain two objective tasks each.

Writing – one text approximately 50 words (short biographic data, answering questions; description; short text on specific topic, key words or illustrative material; greeting; invitation)

The speaking section includes a conversation on an assigned topic and a description of a picture (a monolog)




