

STUDENTS' SCHOLARSHIPS

TYPES OF SCHOLARSHIPS AND NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR APPLYING

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR WINTER/ SUMMER SEMESTER:

Scholarships for the winter or summer semester are granted from the beginning of the second and subsequent semesters by order of the Rector and are paid over a period of 5 months.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

Eligible applicants for academic achievement scholarship are students, who have successfully passed all examinations in accordance with the academic curriculum till the beginning of the semester which they apply for, and their GPA from the previous two semesters* (for first year students – the GPA from winter semester) is not lower than Good 4.00.

**the GPA from the previous two semesters = (sum of grades in all mandatory subjects and the highest two grades in elective subjects for the period) / total number of grades.*

Students whose last year of studies is the pre-graduate internship, the GPA of the previous two semesters (when applying for the summer semester) is considered the GPA of the two semesters before the start of the pre-graduate internship.

First year students are eligible to apply for scholarships from the second semester of their studies.

Important: STUDENTS WITHOUT PASSING ALL THE EXAMS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR ANY TYPE OF SCHOLARSHIP.

Ranking is performed in descending order of GPA, by quotas for the specialities and courses, until the allocated scholarship numbers are exhausted, determined by a Decision of a Committee appointed by Rector's Order of MU-Varna.

Necessary documents for applying:

- Scholarship application, submitted online through the student's profile in [WebStudent](#).
- Certificate for Bank Account, issued by Bulgarian Bank Institution.

INCOME AND ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

Eligible applicants for income and academic achievement scholarship are students, who have successfully passed all examinations in accordance with the academic curriculum till the beginning of the semester which they apply for, and their GPA from the previous two semesters* (for first year students – the GPA from winter semester) is not lower than Good 4.00.

Students whose last year is a pre-graduate internship, the GPA of the previous two semesters (when applying for a summer semester) is considered the GPA of the two semesters before the start of the pre-graduate internship.

First year students are eligible to apply for scholarships from the second semester of their studies.

Important: STUDENTS WITHOUT PASSING ALL THE EXAMS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR ANY TYPE OF SCHOLARSHIP.

The score for this scholarship is formed by the formula:

(the GPA from the previous two semesters - 4) x 100 + (409,03 - the average monthly gross income) / 2, where

****the GPA from the previous two semesters = (sum of grades in all mandatory subjects and the highest two grades in elective subjects for the period) / total number of grades***

Important: Applicants with negative score or score equal to 0 will not be eligible for ranking

Ranking is performed in descending order of the Score, by quotas for the specialities and courses, until the allocated scholarship numbers are exhausted, determined by a Decision of a Committee appointed by Order of the Rector of MU-Varna.

Necessary documents for applying:

- Scholarship application, submitted online through the student's profile in [WebStudent](#);
- Certificate for Bank Account, issued by Bulgarian Bank Institution;
- Documents certifies the average monthly gross income of the student;
- Documents certifies the average monthly gross income of student's family members]
- Certificates for marital status if necessary.

Granting amounts for academic achievements scholarships:

- for GPA **6.00** – 110 Euro/month
- for GPA **from 5.50 to 5.99** – 100 Euro/month
- for GPA **from 5.00 to 5.49** – 90 Euro/month
- for GPA **from 4.00 to 4.99** – 80 Euro/month

SIGNIFICANT ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

(scholarship for special achievements in science, arts, culture and sport)

Eligible applicants for significant achievements scholarship are students who have successfully passed all examinations in accordance with the academic curriculum till the beginning of the semester which they apply for, and their GPA from the previous two semesters* (for first year students – the GPA from winter semester) is not lower than Good 4.00.

Participation in scientific, sports or artistic activities should be held in the semester for which the application is being made or in the previous semester.

Ranking is based on the category of achievement, and in case of equal achievements - based on the GPA from the previous two semesters, until the allocated scholarship numbers are exhausted.

Necessary documents for applying:

- Scholarship application, submitted online through the student's profile in [WebStudent](#);
- Certificate for Bank Account, issued by Bulgarian Bank Institution.

- Copy of a scientific-research paper with names of the author; diploma and award from an international or national scientific forum + Confirmation note, signed by the Head of the Project and the Head of the Department from MU Varna

- Copy of a scientific-research article, published in Bulgarian or international scientific magazine on paper; copy of the title page of the magazine with publication date + Confirmation note, signed by the Head of the Project and the Head of the Department from MU Varna

- Diploma or certificate for winning a gold, silver or bronze medal, or first, second or third place in a sports competition at an international, national or regional level + Confirmation note, signed by trainer and the Head of Physical Education and Sports of MU-Varna

- Diploma or certificate for winning a gold, silver or bronze medal, or first, second or third place in an arts competition at an international, national or regional level + Confirmation note, signed by the Head of Arts Activities of MU-Varna

Granting amount for significant achievement scholarship – 100 Eur /month

YEAR-ROUND SCHOLARSHIP UNDER ART.3 PARA.2 UNDER PMC 90:

Eligible applicants for the year-round scholarship under art.3, para. 2 are students for the following categories:

- Single students without two parents;
- Students with permanent disabilities;
- Students with two parents with permanent disabilities;
- Students with one parent with permanent disabilities;
- Students – mothers with a child up to 6 years old;
- Students – fathers with a child up to 6 years old, when the mother is not a student.

The scholarship would be granted to students who have successfully passed all examinations in accordance with the academic curriculum till the beginning of the semester which they apply for and is paid over a period of 12 months.

Important: STUDENTS WITHOUT PASSING ALL THE EXAMS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR ANY TYPE OF SCHOLARSHIP.

Granting amount for year-round scholarship – 100 Eur /month

Necessary documents for applying:

- Scholarship application, submitted online through the student's profile in [WebStudent](#).
- Certificate for Bank Account, issued by Bulgarian Bank Institution
- Documents certifies the category on the basis of which he/she is applying

Important:

All documents used to apply for scholarship MUST be OBLIGATORY attached to the application in the student's profile in Webstudent, following the applying steps published on the web page of MU Varna. On-site documents will be reviewed ONLY upon request.

Documents issued abroad should be issued by the relevant competent institution/authority on the territory of the country where the document originates.

Documents issued from abroad must be legalized, translated into Bulgarian and certified in accordance with the provisions of the international treaties of the Republic of Bulgaria with the country in which they were issued.
