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IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS OF MEDICAL UNIVERSITY - VARNA

IMMUNIZATION AGAINST HEPATITIS B VIRUS

Dear Students,

In accordance with the health legislation of the Republic of Bulgaria, immunization with a vaccine against hepatitis B virus (HBV) has become mandatory for all newborns since 1992. In addition, **all health professionals,** working at high risk of exposure to biological agents, including blood transmitted viruses - hepatitis B virus, need to be given the required specific immunoprophylaxis.

The specific immunoprophylaxis against HBV can be carried out with two types of bioproducts:

- Engerix B Mono Vaccine product Hepatitis B Recombinant Vaccine;
- Twinrix Bivalent Vaccine an inactivated vaccine against HBV and HAV (hepatitis A virus)

Engerix B is recommended for initial, mandatory immunization of newborns, re-immunization of risk groups with an insufficient protective antibody titer and non-immunized adults.

Twinrix is recommended for persons born before 1992, who haven't been mandatory immunized.

Immunization and re-immunization against HBV shall be preceded by HbsAg test. Only persons with / - / HBsAg shall be subject to immunoprophylaxis!

Immunization Schedule for **Non-Immunized** Persons with Engerix-B:

- 1st dose randomly chosen day;
- 2nd dose after 1 month;
- 3rd dose six months after the first dose.

Re-immunization with Engerix B:

Re-immunization shall be carried out after prior laboratory testing of post-infectious/post-vaccination immunity - titer of anti-HBs (<u>titer below 10</u> mlU/ml).

Re-immunization is carried out with one dose of Engerix B, which shall be followed by a test of the titer of specific antibodies after a month.

In case of a negative titer, a new full immunization cycle with 3 doses of vaccine and a new immunity test shall be carried out.

Immunization Schedule for Non-Immunized Persons with Twinrix:

- 1st dose randomly chosen day;
- 2nd dose after 1 month;
- 3rd dose six months after the first dose.

An Accelerated Immunization Schedule with Twinrix for Travellers/Students:

- 1st dose randomly chosen day;
- 2nd dose after 7 days;
- 3rd dose 21 days after the first dose;
- 4th dose 1 year after the first dose.

Twinrix is recommended for:

- Non-immunized persons and persons who have not been affected by HBV and HAV:
 - Working age people 25-40 years of age;
 - Travellers and students abroad;
 - Persons who have been in contact with people infected with viral hepatitis;
 - Immunocompromised persons.

Both vaccines are available in the pharmacies, at an approximate price per 1 dose:

- Engerix B 25-35 lev
- Twinrix -50-60 lev

The immunization can be carried out in the Immunization Room of Regional Health Inspectorate - Varna (3 Bregalnitca Srt.), payment required as follows: 1st dose - 7 lev, second dose - 2 lev, 3rd dose - 2 lev.
